Christian Education- Children and Youth: FYSH continues to meet once a month following Sunday's later Worship Service. Approximately six members of the youth group plan to attend the Youth Assembly in St. Simons in February. The Children's class has completed the "Seasons of the Spirit" curriculum and is following a schedule of Bible stories that reflects the Godly Play series.

Adult Education: The Eco-theology class has been commissioned to present a Green Chalice Program proposal to the church board. This class will soon go on hiatus and meet as issues arise.
